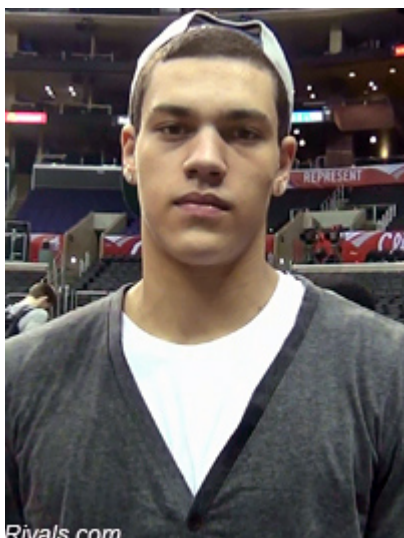

Four schools remain in the mix for **Gavin Schilling**, who has seen his stock rise since making the move from the midwest to the west.

Gavin Schilling quietly narrowed his college list on Thursday night.

Villanova, Minnesota, Michigan State and UCLA made the cut for the 2013 6-foot-9 power forward from Findlay Prep (NV), by way of Chicago.

On the same night that Minnesota coach **Tubby Smith** was in to see the crafty forward play, Schilling made the decision. Up next will be taking some visits, which could happen sooner than expected, including this weekend.

The three-star prospect will be on the UCLA campus this coming weekend, and hopes to make it out to Michigan State and Villanova in March for official visits. Last month, when he was back home, Schilling made an unofficial trip to East Lansing after the Spartans turned up the heat on his recruitment following **Jabari Parker** to Duke.

"Since he's been at Findlay Prep, the 6-foot-9 forward has improved tremendously on both ends of the court, especially physically. He is not only more mobile but also significantly stronger," Rivals analyst **Corey Albertson** said last month.
